Today the world stares the Negro in the face and demands of him an account of his stewardship.

World Has Left Us Behind

For thousands of years we have mixed with the rest of mankind and now when all the races are boasting of their individual and collective progress—the progress of modern times—the race to which we belong has, perforce, to take the hindmost position because of the lack of this world's goods.

Whites Rule With Brute Force

In the great achievements of this modern world the white man, as also the yellow man, can boast of his constructed empires and dominions; he can point to his prowess upon land and sea; his position in temporal affairs is secure, thus he is able to rule with pride and satisfaction to himself.

We Must Act or Be Lost

How long is the Negro going to be satisfied to be a slave and a serf? The call for an accounting of the stewardship of the race is now, and we must be up and doing, for if we are found wanting much longer our sacred cause of liberty will be lost to us forever.

No Color Line Within Race

Black men and women the world over, I am begging you to come together. There must be no color line within the race, there must be but the Negro. The Negro has been despised for centuries, but if he will only rise to the occasion today he will find himself a man tomorrow. Let Ethiopia stretch forth her

hands and call her children to attention and to arms—the arms of industrial and commercial might. Let no scattered son or daughter fail to answer the call, whether you are called black or colored, for there is but one race, the Negro race, that must triumph as soon as we rise 400,000,000 strong.

Conquer Your Portion of World

There must be no East, no West, no South where the Negro is concerned—there must be a united race. Rise, Negroes, in your industrial and commercial might and conquer your portion of the world! There is enough in the world for black, white and yellow. The white man has his share, the yellow man is getting his share, and the Negro must now organize and take his.

Africa the Envied of All

When I survey the world of political activity I see Africa the envied goal of all races. Africa, by the plan of the other races, is to be the mart of exploitation, it is to be the "No Man's Land" of the races while Europe remains in the hands of the white man and Asia of the yellow man. Unconsciously the Negro slept for five hundred years, and thereby gave the impression to an envious and avaricious world that all were welcome to Africa, but today the Negro is fully awake and he is saying to all comers: "Thus far in Africa and no further."

Africa Defies a Mad World

Africa supplied forty million slaves to the Western world. Africa bled that others might live, but today Africa, through wounds inflicted, has recovered from her affliction and in the full strength of her manhood and womanhood is hurling her defiance to a mad world.

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HOW TO BE HEALTHY

VARIETY IN DIET
By CHARLES F. BOLDUAN, M. D., Department of Health, City of N. Y.
Meals to be tempting, nourishing and healthful need not be expensive. And to have a well-balanced diet almost every day in the week is possible if the cook in the family just uses a little ingenuity in the selection and preparation of the food that goes to make up the meal.

With such a wide variety of vegetables, fruits, meats and poultry at hand it is not a difficult problem to arrange a day-to-day menu that will not bore the family's palate. And there should be a wide variety of food eaten in every home, for it is variety that not only pleases the eye, but the stomach as well. A meal that "will make the mouth water," also has the same effect on the stomach, for the latter organ often rebels at a repetition of foods.

Even a well-balanced diet, healthful as it is, will not have the proper nutritive effect if it is not frequently changed. With food prices at the present level the proper balance in meals can be maintained and yet changed daily.

Unnumerable meat dishes can be prepared from the less costly cuts. Beef, lamb and mutton steaks can be served, and there is nothing more

nourishing than these dishes, containing, as they do, the juices of the meat and the vegetables as well. Again these same cheap cuts can be braised, made into pies and into any number of other dishes. Stewing chickens also offer cheap dishes in the way of fricassees, ragouts and pies.

The combination of meats and vegetables gives perhaps one of the finest of healthful dishes. Soups, too, are possible, increasing the necessary amount of fluids stimulating the stomach to act.

With so many varieties of vegetables on the market the housewife also has a wide range of choice. Cabbage, kale, cauliflower, string beans, turnips, carrots, tomatoes, celery, are still plentiful and cheap. Fruits also are still available at moderate prices.

So that it is not a hard problem to have a different meat dish, or a fish dish, or more cooked vegetables and a salad, all under a different guise each day of the week. The balanced menu can also be made a varied menu. Every principal meal should contain some dairy product, too, such as cheese—and there are any number of cheese varieties. And each member of the family should have a glass of milk at every meal.

For your own as well as for your family's health vary your diet.

Belgians Remove 'Poison King' in Ruanda, Africa

A dispatch in the daily papers here reports that the Belgian government has shown its hands in Congo affairs again by removing from the throne of Ruanda, in equatorial Africa, Musinga, the king, and placing in his stead, his son, Ludahigwa. Musinga is said to have been removed because of his habit of trying to poison everybody who disagreed with him. Very few of those whom he sought to destroy were affected, but scores of servants died from the effects of food and drink which they were required to sample for their masters.

Negroes Hit by Ark. Bank Crash

JONESBORO, Ark.—The only bank of this community, "The Bank of Jonesboro," failed to open Dec. 14 and is now in the hands of the state banking commission. The failure which strikes many of the local Negro citizens as well as farmers of this territory, is directly traceable to lack of confidence engendered by the failure of banks in other sections of the state early in the fall.

South African Problem Worse

Nothing Being Done for Native Unemployed in the Union

DURBAN, So. Africa.—Report sent in by several Joint Councils to the S. A. Institute of Race Relations show that the problem of unemployment among natives in the towns has grown rapidly during the last few months. Reports from rural areas also show that large numbers of natives have returned home for whom there is no land available, while the present is not enough to aggravate the position very considerably. Enquiries in various parts of the country indicate that the proceeds of native taxation for the current year will probably show a drop of between 20 and 30 per cent due to the extent of native unemployment and distress.

Considerable hardship is likely to be inflicted upon Natives who are unable to pay their general and local tax since total exemption is only given in cases of permanent inability to work. Unemployed Natives may be given further time in which to pay but the liability accumulates, so that a Native may find himself faced with a demand for payment of two years' taxes at once.

The recently published notice by the Minister of Native Affairs regarding the treatment of Natives who are unable to pay their taxes is heartily welcomed and will ease a little the unfortunate position of unemployed Natives. Nevertheless they feel that they are being hit on both cheeks for while they are suffering severely from the policy of displacing Native labor to make room for white unemployed they are also called upon to pay taxes, the means for which have been taken from them by the government.

Ordain African Priest At Notre Dame Cathedral

WASHINGTON.—Word reached here last week that in the world famous cathedral of Notre Dame in Paris, there was ordained recently a Negro priest, who was the first member of his race ever to officiate in the noted cathedral.

The priest was Father Joseph Frye, a Senegalese born in Africa only 26 years ago. He was ordained by a bishop of the church in the presence of several thousands Catholic communicants.

Notre Dame, next to St. Paul's Cathedral in Rome, is one of the most famous Catholic edifices in the world. A beautiful Gothic cathedral, standing between two tiny branches of the River Seine, its queer gargoyles figures have looked over the city of Paris for many centuries. It was here for the first time that a 26-year-old Negro priest consecrated himself to the work of the church in the presence of witnesses of all ages.

Jail White Lawyer Defending Negro

MEMPHIS, Tenn.—Attorney Clarence Friedman, who was engaged in defending Joe Clark on the charge of carrying a concealed weapon, last Friday, but before the case was over found himself upon the defensive with a 10-day jail sentence and a \$50 fine confronting him.

Friedman had insinuated that the assistant attorney general had coached an 11-year-old colored girl to say that she had seen Clark with the pistol according to the assistant attorney general, Marion Boyd and in his effort to overcome that suggestion an argument developed.

Judge Wallace ordered Friedman to sit down and stop talking. The latter did neither. The judge sentenced him to 10 days in court and added a fine of \$50 for contempt. It was expected that Friedman would apologize to the court and gain his freedom. Instead, failing to get a writ of habeas corpus, he went to jail.

Negroes Are Left to Hold the Bag

BOSTON, Mass.—When white union longshoremen struck here several weeks ago for higher wages and better working conditions, Negro strikebreakers were called in to take their place. The result is described in the following editorial from the Austin American.

"Boston longshoremen to the number of 200 went on strike, October 3. Their places were filled by non-union Negro strikebreakers. Now the strike is over. The 800 white longshoremen have returned to their jobs, the strike ended in a victory for the operators, the strikers withdrawing their demand for retention of working conditions more favorable than those prevailing in New York and other parts, and lastly—the Negro non-union workers have been removed from the piers as well as their jobs. Of course, the expected happened. Now the Negroes are jobless. They are holding the empty bag."

THE HIGHER SELF

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Freedom Worth A Million Lives

Says Mahatma Gandhi in First Speech on Landing in India

BULLETIN Gandhi Jailed

BOMBAY, Jan. 4.—Mahatma Gandhi was arrested under dramatic circumstances at 3 a. m. and borne away to prison; he predicted a "reign of terror" with British troops shooting natives; Vallabhai Patel, president of National Congress, was also seized.

Nationalists declared a general suspension of work, and thousands of shops in India were closed as a sign of mourning; government was prepared to outlaw the Nationalist Congress, and wholesale arrests of men and women adherents were expected.

British government of India would employ financial pressure, and not mere repression and arrests, London sources said; postal included refusal of railway, post and telegraph facilities to Indian business firms aiding Gandhi.

BOMBAY, India—Mahatma Gandhi declared today that he would not flinch at sacrificing the lives of 1,000,000 people to purchase the liberty of India.

The Mahatma made this statement to 50,000 white-capped Nationalists gathered in an open field to hear his first speech since his return from the London Round Table Conference. He spoke from a lofty platform made of stout bamboo poles, festooned with the Nationalist colors—white, red and green—and surmounted by a spinning wheel.

The crowd was considerably smaller than the audiences Gandhi addressed before he left for England, and some observers said he had lost in prestige because of the failure of the London conference. The listeners broke into applause infrequently, and there were no displays of the old fervent and militant revolutionary spirit.
